Abstract

SHOCK:

- RESULTS FROM THE WIDESPREAD FAILURE OF THE CIRCULATORY SYSTEM TO OXYGENATE AND NOURISH THE BODY ADEQUATELY. (ROSEN)

SHOCK:

- IS CIRCULATORY INSUFFICIENCY THAT CREATES AN IMBALANCE BETWEEN TISSUE OXYGEN SUPPLY (DELIVERY) AND OXYGEN DEMAND (CONSUMPTION). (TINTINALLI)

MORTALITY:

- Septic shock has an estimated mortality of 40% to 60%.
- Cardiogenic shock has an estimated mortality of 36% to 56.4
- Approximately 30% to 45% of patients with septic shock and 60% to 90% of patients with cardiogenic shock die within 1 month of presentation.
