Dear Readers

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of International Journal of Anesthesiology & Pain Medicine, volume 5 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online. The objective of IPAPM is to publish up-to-date, high-quality and original research papers alongside relevant and insightful reviews. Impact factor of IPAPM for the year 2018-2019 was 0.34.

As such, the journal aspires to be vibrant, engaging and accessible, and at the same time integrative and challenging. Each issue of the journal contains different types of papers, mostly the first, Regional Spotlights; provide a short contemporary and provocative “opinion piece” on an issue in the field of Anesthesiology & Pain Medicine. The second, Critical Reviews, provides a critical and concise yet comprehensive and contemporary review of a particular theme specific to the Anesthesiology & Pain Medicine. The third type of paper, Research Papers, was more traditional in form and demonstrated a sound theoretical and/or methodological underpinning and a clear contribution to knowledge in the field.

During the calendar year 2019, IPAPM received around 50 papers, out of which 40 articles (90%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format. During the same year around 8 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and 5 of those were accepted in the 6 issues of Volume 7.

5 articles were published during the year 2019, of which, 70% articles were by foreign authors. A total of 80 research scientists from USA and abroad reviewed the 40 articles published in volume 5. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 1-2 months.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Dr. Anna Woodbury during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, in bringing out issues of IPAPM in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of IPAPM, the office bearers and staff for their support in bringing out yet another volume of IPAPM and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 6 of IPAPM in scheduled time.
